


General Overview of Course Risks

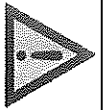
1. Typical hazards encountered on a Golf Course.	Golfers, Greens Staff and spectators.	Strict adherence to the Rules and Etiquette of Golf, observe all signs and be aware of rules concerning cessation of play in dangerous weather or conditions.	Low
2. Teeing Off Miss hit Tee shot to right or left	Other Golfers on adjacent greens, fairways, or paths	Don't tee off until you are sure that the group in front are out of range. Don't tee off if any of your playing partners are standing forward of you. Don't tee off if anyone is walking toward the tee from any adjacent holes. Don't stand forward of a player teeing off. Don't walk towards a tee when someone is preparing to drive Pay attention when playing shot and shout fore if ball drifts to left or right and there is any likelihood of hitting someone.	Medium
3. Rights of way	Members of public and dog walkers on paths or fairways	Pay attention when playing shot and shout fore if ball drifts to left or right and there is any likelihood of hitting someone.	Medium
4. Fairway to Green	Other Golfers	Don't take a shot until you are sure that the group in front are out of range. Don't take a shot if your playing partners are forward of you and in range. Stand in a safe position when a playing partner is taking a shot	Medium
5. Miss hit approach shot to green	Players on adjacent holes	Be aware of players in this area and shout fore if hitting to left or right past green and there is any likelihood of hitting someone.	Medium
6. Streams, Riverbeds, Ponds Lakes	All Golfers	Be aware of the dangers of streams, riverbeds (wet or dry, muddy areas), lakes, ponds including slipping down banks, deep water and slippery bridges. Don't step onto frozen water. Use ball retrievers whenever possible. Appropriate holes 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, 12, 13	Medium
7. Hidden Greens	Other Golfers, Greens Staff	Don't play to Greens until you are sure that the group in front have left. Greens that may be hidden from view for approach shot are holes - none	Low

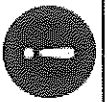
8. Trees and other fixed hazards	Golfers and Playing partners	When playing near trees beware of balls ricocheting.	Low
9. Undulating ground, hollows, hills	All Golfers	Take care when walking over undulating ground especially when wet or icy. Appropriate to holes: 2, 3, 12, 15, 17	medium
10. Driving Buggies	All Golfers	Take care on hills, hollows, and undulations. Take special care driving over bridges or near to brooks and on inclines. Keep speed to minimum.	Medium

	Miss-hit tee shot to right from White Tee	People on Putting Green Players in Buggies coming down from 18th	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
	Balls coming from Driving range over net	You	Take care when walking along fairway and listen out for Fore Range being shouted	Medium
	Tee shot from White tee if behind trees	You	Take care when walking along fairway and listen out for Fore being shouted	Low
	Green Approach shot drifts left	Players walking to 2 nd Tee	Trees to be regularly trimmed by greens staff Pay attention when playing shot and shout fore if ball drifts to left and there is any likelihood of hitting someone.	Low
	Over hit approach to Green	Vehicles or people going down road	Pay attention when playing shot especially if vehicles are known to be coming down road.	Low

	Miss-hit tee Shot to the right	People playing the 18 th	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
	Miss-hit tee shot to the left	People on the 16 th Tee	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Hole 2				
	Balls hit over the left hand side of the hole	Dog walkers and golfers	If you cannot see your ball land shout fore	Medium




Miss-hit tee Shot to the right	Golfers on the 6 th Tee/ 5 th green	If your ball is heading towards the direct of the 6 th tee and 5 th Green. Shout fore	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the left	Road users	We are growing out the hedges and tree to form a barrier	Low
Miss-hit tee Shot to the right	Golfers on the 5 th	<i>Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.</i>	Medium
Playing into the green	Golfers on the 4 th Tee	<i>Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.</i>	Low

Miss Hit over the green (Thinned)	Golfers on the 5 th Hole	<i>Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.</i>	Low
Hole 5			
Miss-hit tee Shot to the Left	Golfers on the 6 th Hole	<i>Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.</i>	High
Miss-hit tee Shot to the right	Golfers on the 3 rd Hole	<i>Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.</i>	Medium

Playing second shot miss hit left	Players on the 5 th Tee Box	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit Long over green (thinned)	Golfers on the 9 th Green	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Hole 8			
Miss-hit tee Shot to the Left	Players on the 9 th Hole	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Playing into the green	Players on the 9 th Tee Box	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the Left	Players on 8 th Hole	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Miss-hit tee Shot to the Right	Players on the 15 th Holes	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the left	Houses & 11 th Tee	Installed fencing to encourage players to aim at the right hand side of the green	Low
Miss-hit tee Shot to the Long	14 th green	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Low
Tee shots towards the front left tee box	Walkers on Public foot path	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the left	Players on the 12 th Tee	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Tee shots towards the left hand side fairway	Walkers on Public foot path	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium



Approach shot long	Golfers on the 13 th Tee box	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Low

Miss-hit tee Shot to the left	Walker on public foot path	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Miss-hit shot long	Players on the 14 th tee	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the left	Players 15 th Fairway	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium



Playing towards the green (left)	Players 14 th hole	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Playing towards the green (Right)	Players 9 th hole	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the left	Railway	Wait until the train has passed before hitting your tee shot	Low
Miss-hit tee Shot to the Right	Players 18 th fairway and 1 st Green	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Miss-hit tee shot	Players walking from 1 st Green to 2 nd Tee	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	High
Playing towards the green	Players 18 th Tee	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the long	8 th Hole (9 Hole)	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium

Miss-hit tee Shot to the Right	Players 16 th and 1 st Hole	Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Miss-hit Approach shot (Right)	1 st Tee (18 Hole)	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Medium
Miss-hit Approach shot (Left)	1 st Tee (9 Hole)	Check for players in these areas before taking shot. Shout fore if your ball is likely to go near to them.	Low


